Opening Procedures during Governments easing of lockdown restrictions September 2020

If you or any member of your household have a cough, high temperature loss of taste or smell or are feeling unwell, you must stay at home, book a test and follow Government guidelines.

The club will be open on Wednesday, and Sunday between 1100hrs and 1600hrs to full and probationary members but **only if you have booked a morning or afternoon slot on line via the club web site**. There will be a maximum of 12 spaces each day. Key holders can now book a 2-hour slot following the booking in procedures, there will be a maximum of 4 key holders per day 1100hrs and 1300hrs If the club is closed on non-club days you will not be able to book a slot

- 1. When arriving at club if the gates are locked stay in your car until they are opened then drive up to club house. Enter club when told after sanitising hands. Do not arrive early or open gates if you are not that day's Duty Officer. Leave space for the Duty Officer to be first in line if he arrives after you
- 2. Social distancing at 2 meters apart is always your responsibility at all times, markers on the floor are for your guidance. A no contact thermometer is available for everyone's peace of mind.
- 3. Before entering club room, it is compulsory to Sanitise your hands or gloves if wearing them. Use the soap from the dispenser or use your own hand sanitizer or club sanitiser. PPE is your responsibility
- 4. Hand wash dispensers available by front door, in disabled toilet and in kitchen area. Foot operated disposal bins are provided for paper towels only, please take all other items of rubbish home with you
- 5. Normal signing in cards and the Fire book are now being used. When you sign in on the day you will be agreeing to follow the new procedures and accepting all risk associated with Coronavirus Covid19
- 6. Target stands on the 50 and 25 ranges should be left in place just carry and take away your paper target
- 7. The armoury will now be open for Ammunition and targets. Under £5 please have the correct money, over £5 please pay by Bank Transfer, the club details are displayed at duty officers' desk
- 8. Once you have signed in you must take your personal belongings and bagged rifle straight to the firing point, all work and cleaning must be done at home or on your bench, the preparation room is open for limited work with no more than two people at a time
- 9. Access to the 50yd range is via the 10meter range.
- 10. Tea or coffee is not available, please bring your own refreshments and drinking utensils and take home
- 11. Chatting, sitting in club room, banter is all encouraged normally, but these are not normal times. The club room is for **passage only**. Stay in the open on the range or car park, you are here to shoot
- 12. The indoor 10meter air rifle range and co2 range is closed.
- 13. All ranges are restricted to 3 shooters at a time on 3 benches spaced at least 2 meters apart
- 14. Shooting and social distancing at 2 meters apart is always your responsibility although we know you may have to walk behind someone on the bench if you arrive later or finish earlier. Do not stop.
- 15. Normal club safety and range orders apply one shooter must be a dedicated range officer
- 16. On leaving shooting position wipe down everything you have touched with paper towel and Bacterial spray provided on range, dispose of paper towel in bin provided
